Astrology in Action

Yesterday afternoon, January 20th, 2009, I was going down the outside steps so I could drive to the gym for my workout for my right leg which had become weak because of a Sciatica issue of many months. There was a patch of black ice below the bottom step, and I went flying and landed on my left ankle. I also banged up my left shoulder, and left hip. My husband, Rea, was unable to help me stand, and because I have such little strength in my right leg, I couldn't help push myself up, so he called the EMT's. They wanted to take me via ambulance to the hospital, but I refused, and asked them to put me in our car so that Rea could drive me there. I thought that I had only sprained my ankle.

I had ex-rays of my hips, shoulders, chest, and of course my ankle, and was informed that I have broken bones and torn ligaments in my ankle, and will need surgery. Oh Goody!!!! I was put in a temporary cast, given crutches, and told to stay off my left leg. Sure! Right! How can you move forward without using both legs when you have no strength in one leg, and your shoulders are injured?? In order to go from my driveway and into my house, you have to climb 26 steps, so the local EMT's got me back into the house. They said they will come and get me back and forth to the car when needed.

Surgery is scheduled for this Friday (23rd), at which time they will be putting in a steel plate with screws, and whatever else needs to be done. From what the surgeon said, it looks like I won't be able to partake of any more try-outs for the "Pudgy Women's Ice Follies" for at least 6 weeks or more. Damn!!! I really, really wanted to try ice skating on a flat surface, since the icy cement steps try-out didn't work out so well for me. Anyway, if everything works out during surgery, I most likely will be able to come home the same day.

Because of his left leg issues, when we do our shopping at Wal Mart, my husband, Rea, has been using one of their electric wheelchairs, so now we are planning on me also using one so that we can drag race throughout the store.

The doctors have me on prescription "happy pills", so the pain is quite tolerable, the world looks pretty good to me, and everything Rea does is really quite wonderful! He is now desperately trying to figure out how he can wrangle a lifetime prescription for me so he can keep me in that mood.

Textbooks say that accidents are shown by Mars/Uranus aspects, so the first thing I looked for was one of these. Sure enough, in Cissy's chart progressed Mars and Uranus were conjoined within *three minutes*! Their positions were 5:41 Gemini and 5:38 Gemini. (Don't tell *me* that progressions to progressions don't work!) Gemini rules the extremities, shoulders and dexterity.

More amazing was its connections to Hygeia. As most of you know, I've been amazed at that asteroid's activity during times of illness. I had not expected it to be active with an accident.

In Cissy's chart, she has a natal trine between Uranus and Hygeia. At the time of this accident, the progressed Mars/Uranus conjunction was occurring closely trine the natal Hygeia at 5:53 Libra. In other words, they both had moved to be not only next to each other, but also closing this trine aspect. In the birth chart Mars had not been involved; now it was. At the least this would tell us she would not be harmed in the way Natasha Richardson was. The amazing thing though, is that **transiting** Hygeia was at 4:59 Gemini, retrograding away from a conjunction to the progressed Mars/Uranus!

But there is more. Saturn, retrograding at 21:24 Virgo, was activating Cissy's Moon/Venus conjunction in Virgo – right between them – and also square her natal Mars/Saturn conjunction, which squares the first two. This would last awhile and speaks of the limitations now in her life—not to mention the frustration.

It is also noteworthy to point out that accidents happen more often when the Sun is square, conjunct or opposite the birth Sun, and in this case, the Sun was within one

degree of squaring her birth Sun—all in all, a textbook case. By March 5th, she had this to say...

For the past four weeks I have not been out of the house, and today's afternoon temperature was around 66 degrees, so it was a perfect day to venture out into the world. Once we got out onto the highway I almost wanted to poke my head out of the car window like a dog does. By this time, Jupiter in transit and Uranus by solar arc were opposing each other on her ascendant (14:22 Aquarius)—freedom! Humor is also a Uranus/Jupiter gift. Solar Arc Uranus is at 14:15 Leo, very, very close to the descendant. This can be chaos in one's surroundings and often indicates a move—or at least a lot of moving stuff around. Transiting Hygeia stationed right on her natal Uranus, as well, so things were moving quickly. Indeed, her surroundings were very chaotic since they had been about to install new floors, and did so while she was recuperating.
