Money Creators By Carole Devine

I'm late with this issue this time because I was in Georgia speaking in Atlanta and then visiting friends. When I go to North Carolina or Georgia, I always visit a few antique shops since I collect antique cups and saucers and unique birdhouses. While in Elijay, GA, I was browsing one of these shops, and a book caught my eye. A very old, dusty book printed in 1939—the year I was born. It was written in 1934 and the first printing was early 1935. The title is *Money Creators: Who Creates Money? Who Should Create It?* By Gertrude M. Coogan. As I thumbed through the book, it was as if it could have been written yesterday. In fact, when I went online to Amazon to see if it was still available, there are new and used ones selling for over \$80 –lowest was around \$15 (I paid \$1.75 in the antique shop), and it was reprinted as recently as 1982!! This book is a huge eye-opener!

The second chapter is a very well-written explanation of how bankers operate and how it all got started. Here is a quote regarding current bankers:

They and their predecessors inherited a system which, because it IS, they believe always WAS. If they would look into the origin of the system, and examine its nature, originated sub-rosa and only through centuries of legislative trickery congealed into Law, they would demand that the system be demystified, made non-collapsible, and honest in essence; for they would see that the near-by destiny of the system is ruin for them as well as for others.

It explains why the system inevitably puts the bulk of the country's wealth in the hands of a very few with the masses suffering for it. The book was written during the Great Depression and seeks to explain how it happened. (But, here we are today on the verge of another one having learned nothing from history.) She tells us we citizens, alone, are the only ones who can change things by putting pressure on the legislature for an honest money system. After I digest this, I'll be doing an analysis of the Federal Reserve chart and more about the book. Stay tuned. This should be very interesting!

The latest singing sensation captivating the entire globe is an ordinary woman from Scotland. She was born on April 1, 1961 at 9:50 am in Blackburn, Scotland. It's wonderful to be able to delineate a chart showing good news for a change.

First, there were a couple eclipses last January and February activating key positions in her chart. The first at 6 Aq 30 was close to her Jupiter at 2 Aq 49 (and progressed Jupiter at 7 Aq 05) and square her natal Neptune (dreams). The second eclipse at 21 Leo was very close to her natal Uranus at 22 Leo. This eclipse point was being triggered by transiting Jupiter (20 Aq 58 – and could have been exact if we knew the time she debuted) on the day we saw her sing, April 11. Solar arc ascendant is close to her fourth cusp and will exactly conjoin it (and thus oppose the MC) in about ten to eleven months. And secondary progressed ascendant is opposing natal Jupiter (exact in nine months) while progressed Mars is opposing progressed Jupiter within 2 minutes and also on the eclipse point mentioned above!! Clearly, this was a positive life event she agreed to before she was born.

Her life was destined to change around this time. Her solar arc Moon at 29 Scorpio 39 is about to change signs and the week following this debut, Venus retrograde stationed direct at 29 Pisces, trining this solar arc Moon.

Another trigger was transiting Mercury which was at 3 Cap 37 going over the solar arc Mercury in the same degree, both being trined by transiting Pluto. Pluto rules her natal fifth (talent). Where does the talent come from? Neptune in the fifth is usually associated with music and art. It is in a grand trine with Mercury and Mars. Mercury in Pisces can be an angelic voice and when trine Mars, timing is wonderful, but to include Neptune in this would be inspiring –especially in water signs.

Venus rules the fifth, and since it is square Saturn and retrograde, no one reading this chart would predict an easy ascent to prominence. However, Jupiter is next to Saturn in early Aquarius. I have often heard that if success comes to one with that conjunction it is better if Jupiter is in a later position because progressions, transits, etc., would contact Saturn first, and then activate Jupiter—a happy ending. Right now her progressed Sun is trine natal Saturn (exact in six months) but the trine to Jupiter occurs in about four and a half years. That should be a peak of success. In the meanwhile, I'm afraid Ms Boyle will have some things to endure. Solar arc Saturn conjoins her natal Mercury in less than a year, and Saturn, ruling the 8th and IN the 8th would bring some dealings with other people's power and manipulations. Around the same time, Neptune will oppose the Ascendant, and so she will be confused by all this. It's even stronger with transiting Uranus about to square her ascendant. She really needs a good agent.
